Portescap is committed to supplying products worldwide that meet the requirements of its diverse customer base and comply with all applicable governmental regulations. Effective July 1, 2006, the European Union has mandated that certain categories of electrical and electronic equipment sold within Europe must comply with the directive ("restriction on the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment-2002/95/EC") commonly called RoHS. This restricted substances are:


(2) The above products do NOT use the exemption "DecaBDE in polymeric applications".
