Due to reliability issues with the current versions of OSD membrane buttons we are announcing the End-of-Life for the following OSD membrane buttons together with the associated kits. This also includes all custom versions and legacy kits.

KIT 60135-3	KIT, MEMBRANE OSD -VERTICAL, 150MM

New Versions: 5 & 8 Button

Digital View is in the process of creating an improved version of our OSD membrane buttons that is FPC based and uses round embossed buttons. These changes are to improve both the reliability as well as the feel and responsiveness of the buttons.

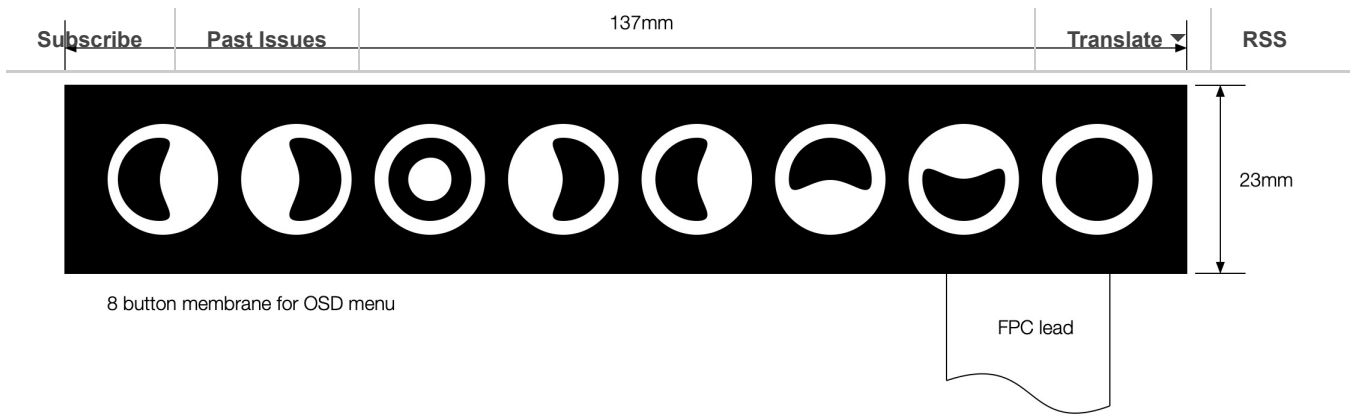

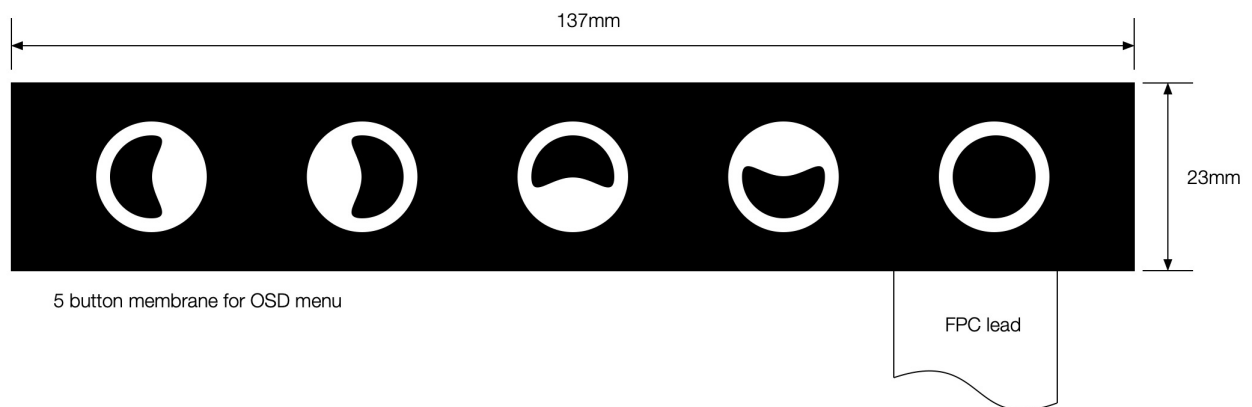
8 Button Version - Proposed
