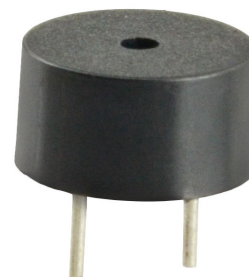

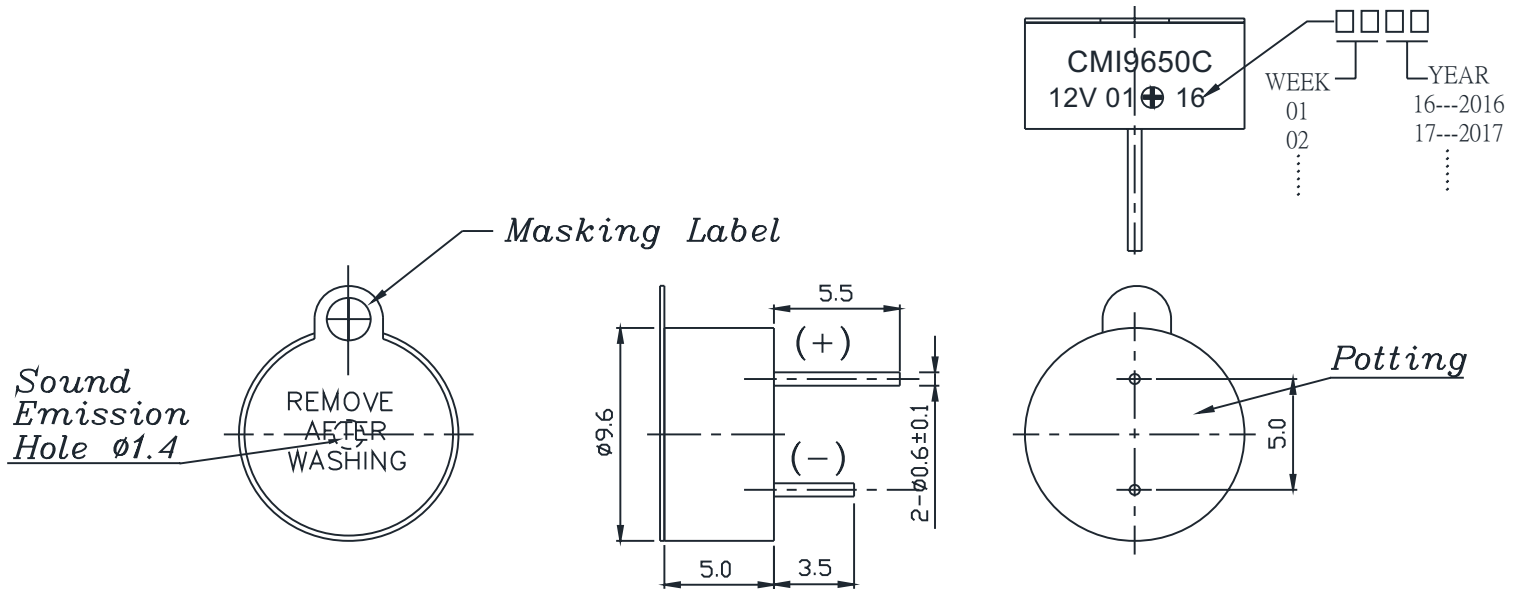

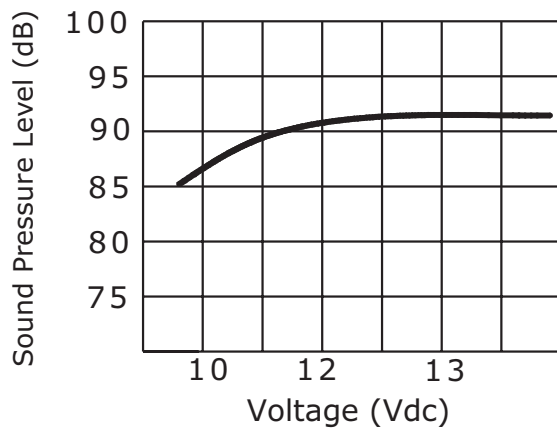

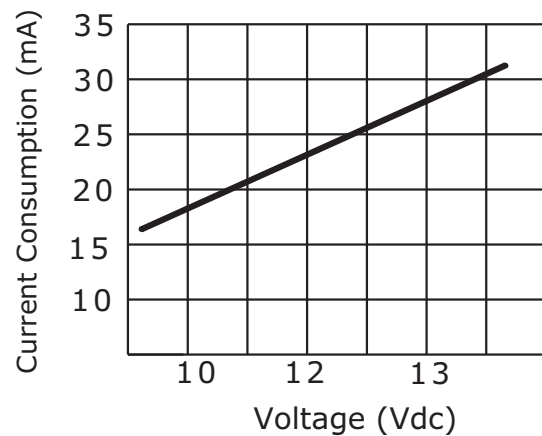


PERFORMANCE CURVES

Voltage vs. Sound Pressure Level at 10 cm, 25°C



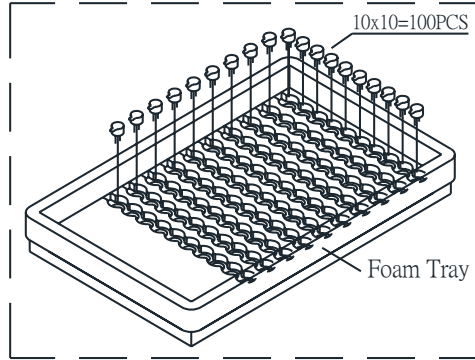
Voltage vs. Current Consumption at 25°C

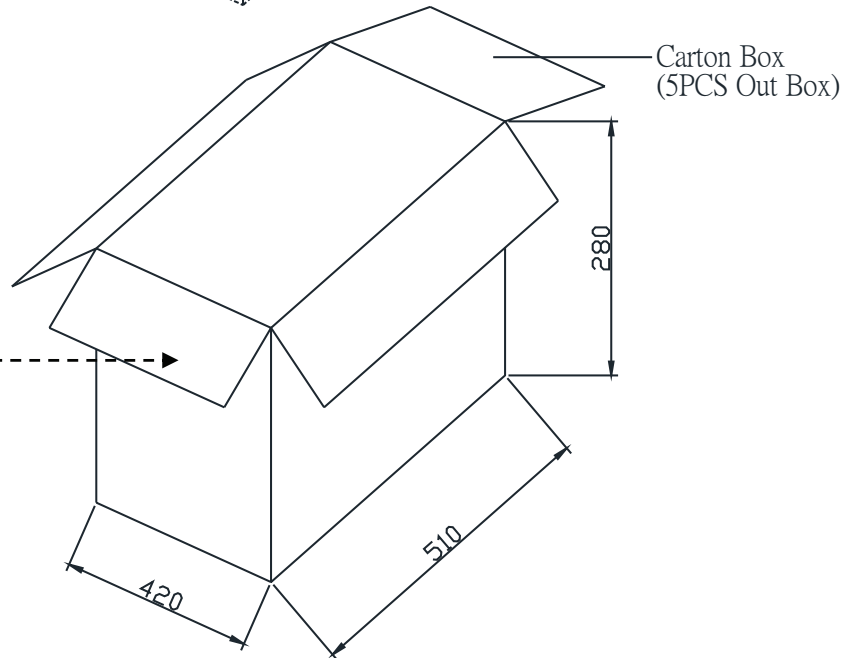
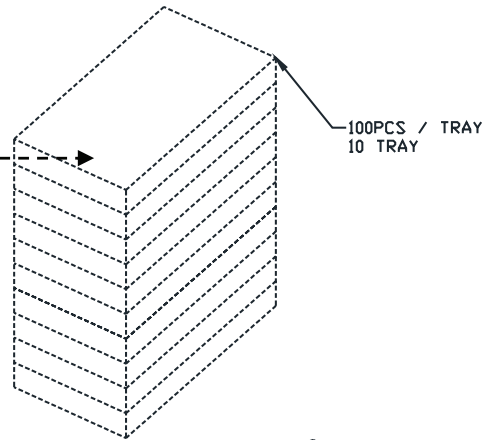
