Reason for Change:	<p>To avoid any possibility of an AirMAX VS contact mating to the unplated side, we are eliminating the single side plated option and recommending double side plated PNs as replacements. Since these are brand new parts, very few are actually in the field. This action is to replace all parts immediately at customers and distributors.</p> <p>Customers & Distributors may scrap any material in place & request a credit from FCI. In case one sided plated PNs are still required, this would be dealt on a case by case basis. For both cases, contact the Product Manager Talee Luo.</p>
