1. General description

ESD protection device in a small SOT23 Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) plastic package, designed to protect two automotive In-vehicle network bus lines from the damage caused by ElectroStatic discharge (ESD) and other transients.

2. Features and benefits

- Reverse stand-off voltage: $V_{RWM} = 24\text{ V}$
- Low clamping voltage: $V_{CL} = 33\text{ V}$ at $I_{PPM} = 3.5\text{ A}$
- Typ. diode capacitance matching: $\Delta C_d/C_d = 0.1\%$
- ESD protection up to 30 kV (IEC 61000-4-2)
- ESD protection up to 30 kV (ISO 10605; $C = 330\text{ pF}$, $R = 330\ \Omega$)
- ISO 7637-3: Pulse a: $V_S = -150\text{ V}$ / Pulse b: $V_S = +100\text{ V}$
- Ultra low leakage current: $I_{RM} = 1\text{ nA}$
- Qualified according to AEC-Q101 and recommended for use in automotive applications

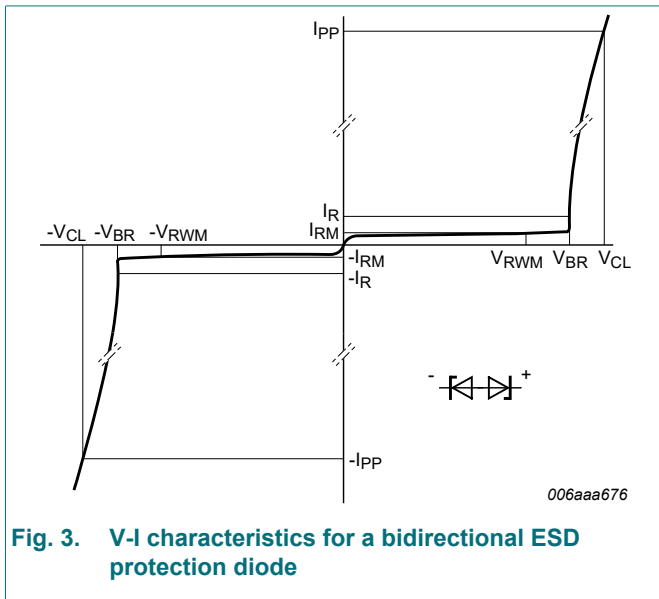


Fig. 3. V-I characteristics for a bidirectional ESD protection diode

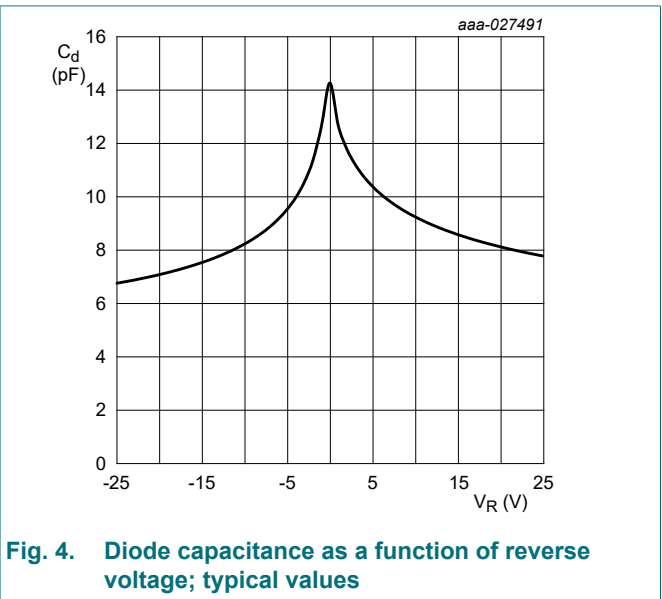


Fig. 4. Diode capacitance as a function of reverse voltage; typical values

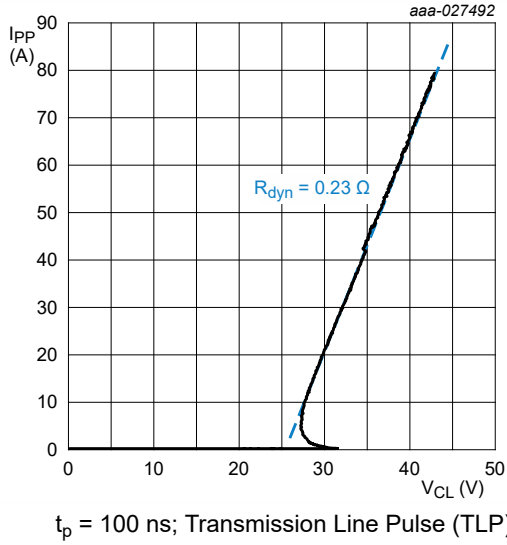


Fig. 5. Positive clamping voltage (TLP); typical values

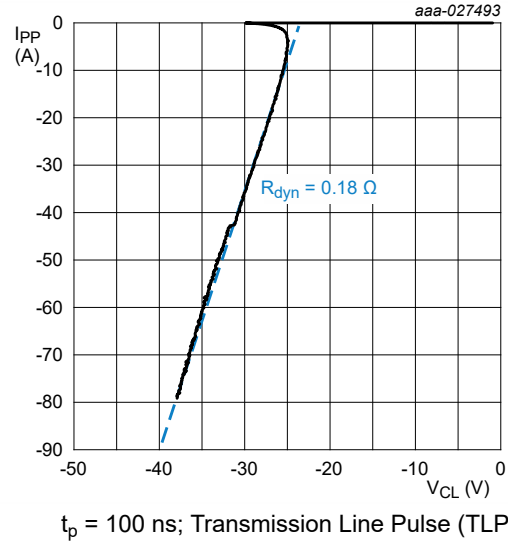


Fig. 6. Negative clamping voltage (TLP); typical values

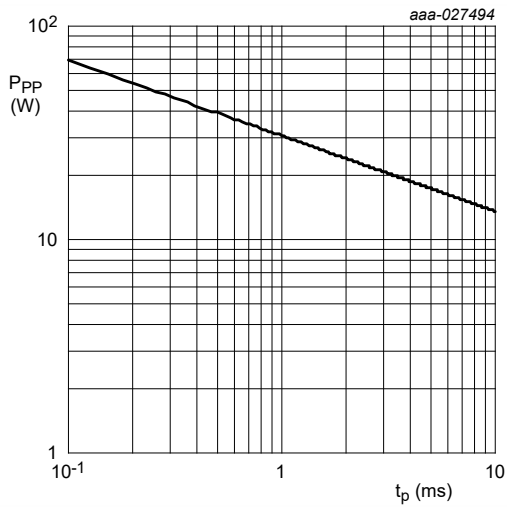


Fig. 7. Peak pulse power as a function of exponential pulse duration; typical values

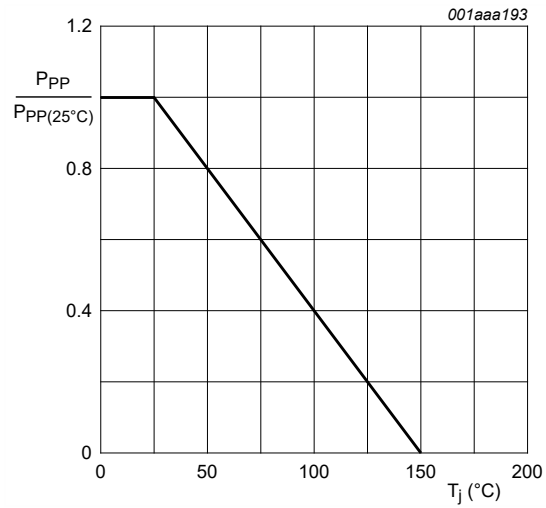
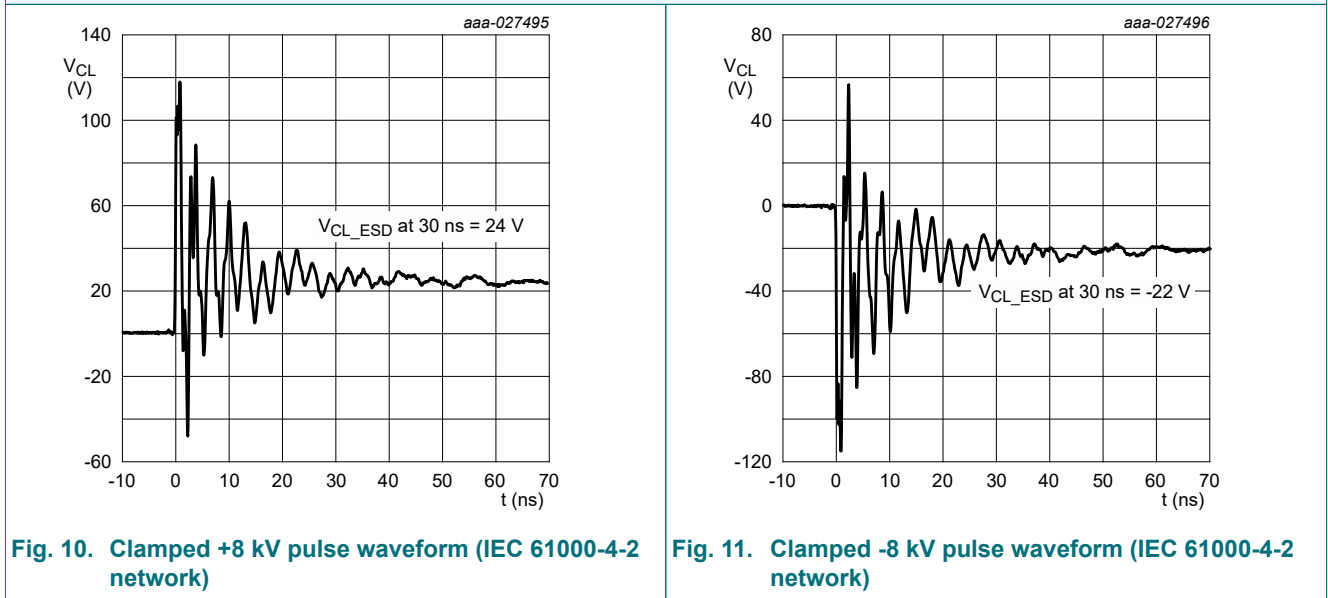


Fig. 8. Relative variation of peak pulse power as a function of junction temperature; typical values

The device is designed for the protection of two automotive IVN bus lines from the damage caused by ESD and surge pulses.

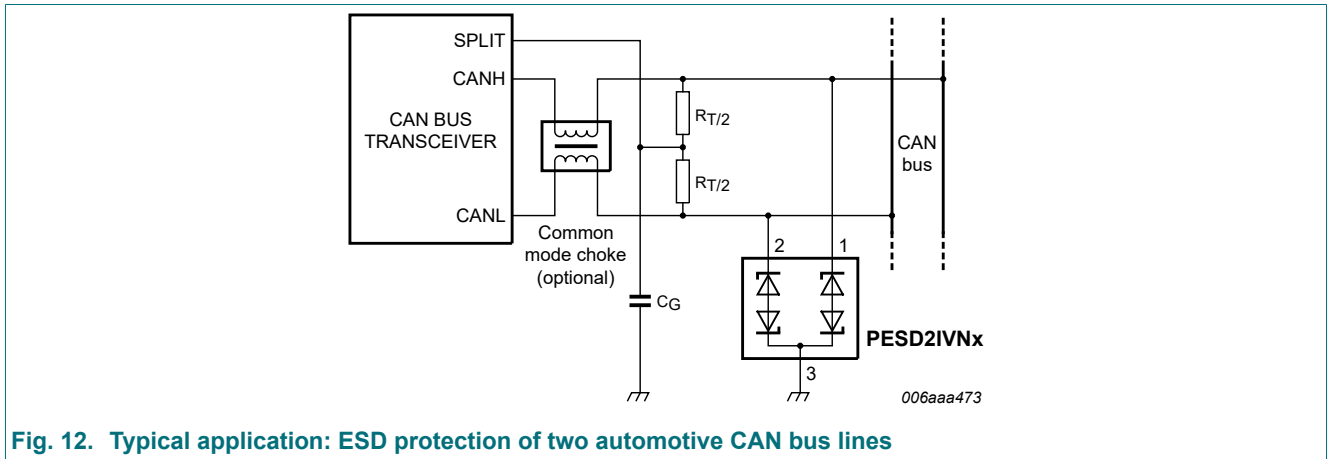


Fig. 12. Typical application: ESD protection of two automotive CAN bus lines

Circuit board layout and protection device placement

Circuit board layout is critical for the suppression of ESD, Electrical Fast Transient (EFT) and surge transients. The following guidelines are recommended:

1. Place the device as close to the input terminal or connector as possible.
2. Minimize the path length between the device and the protected line.
3. Keep parallel signal paths to a minimum.
4. Avoid running protected conductors in parallel with unprotected conductors.
5. Minimize all Printed-Circuit Board (PCB) conductive loops including power and ground loops.
6. Minimize the length of the transient return path to ground.
7. Avoid using shared transient return paths to a common ground point.
8. Use ground planes whenever possible. For multilayer PCBs, use ground vias.

This product has been qualified in accordance with the Automotive Electronics Council (AEC) standard Q101 - *Stress test qualification for discrete semiconductors*, and is suitable for use in automotive applications.

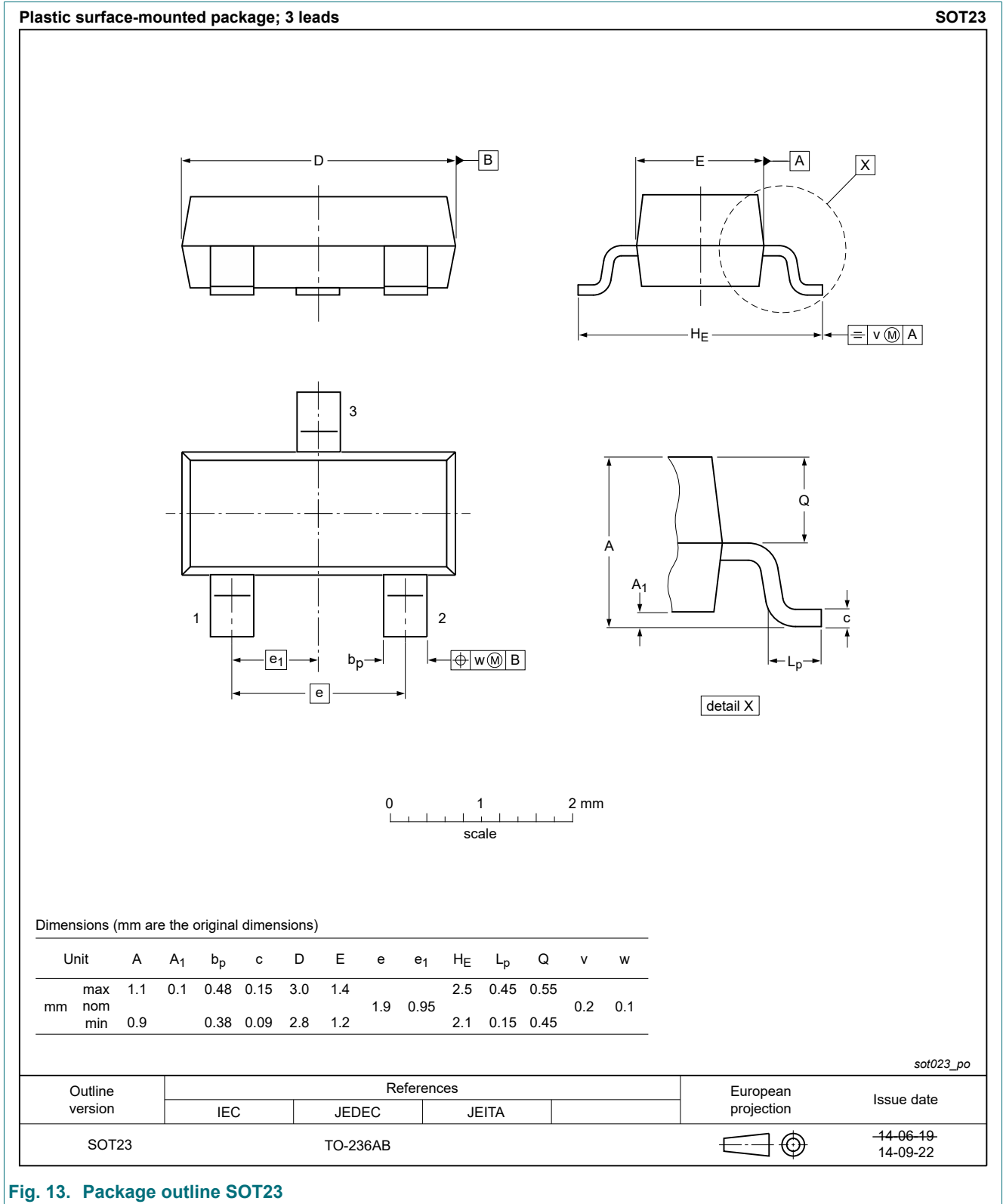


Fig. 13. Package outline SOT23

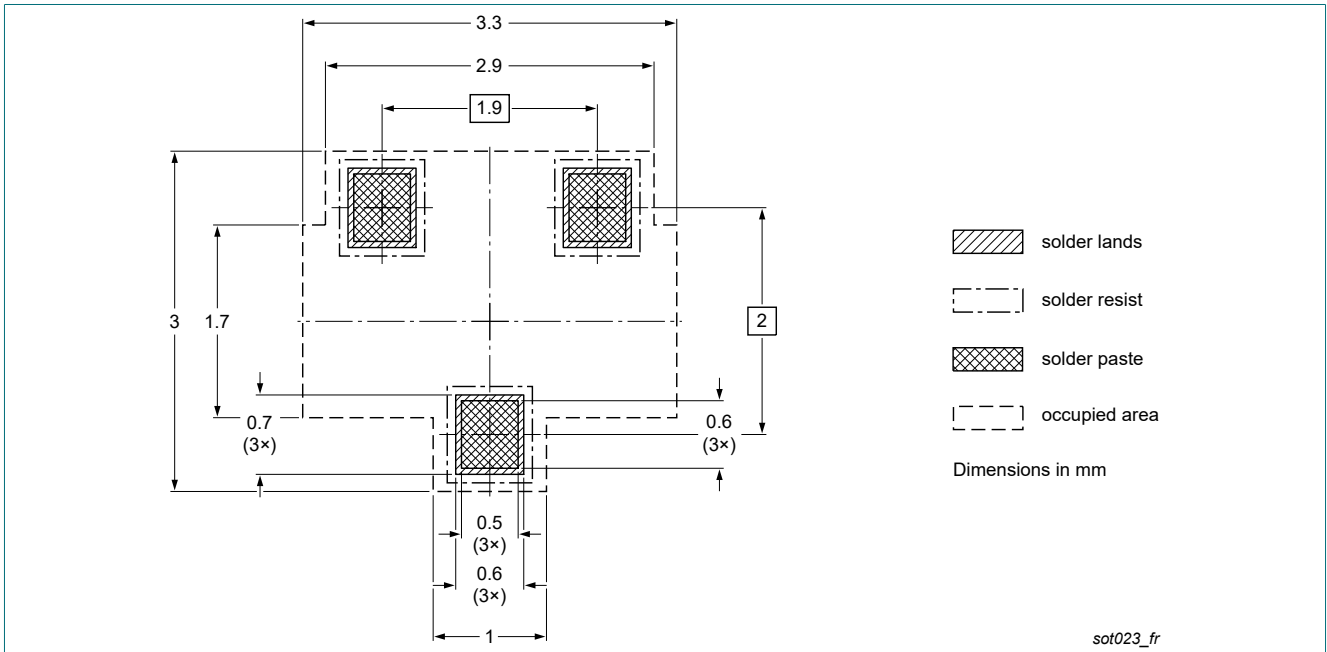


Fig. 14. Reflow soldering footprint for SOT23

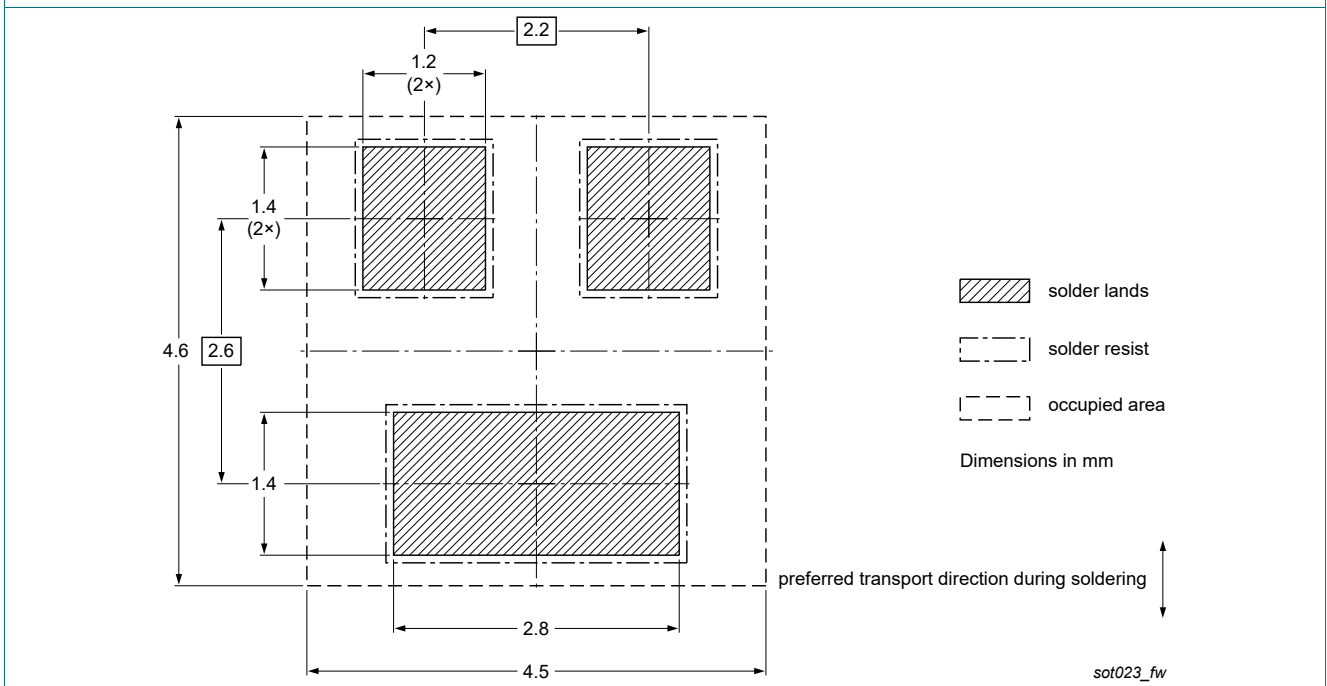


Fig. 15. Wave soldering footprint for SOT23
